

MARK TWAIN LIBRARY AMATUER PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITS

Every two months throughout the year, from January to November, the Mark Twain Library is happy to offer the use of a designated bulletin board for the display of photographs from local amateur photographers.

Basic Rules

1. Only Redding amateur photographers may display their work.
2. The choice of images is left to the photographer, but photographs must be suitable for display in a public library.
3. Photos are restricted by the use of computer enhancements to “brightness, contrast, and sizing of the image”
4. Photos must be between the sizes of 5x7 and 16x30.
5. A maximum of 12 photos may be displayed.
6. Photos must be mounted or matted; no frames.
7. Photos must be submitted to the Library Director one month before the exhibit period. The Director has the right to refuse any photograph considered unacceptable.
8. Photos must be turned in during regular library hours.
9. Photos will be displayed for two calendar months, and must be removed by the photographer by the last day of the second month.
10. Photos not removed will be held for 3 days, and discarded if not collected.
11. Notices and other publicity for the photo exhibits will be handled by the library staff.
12. The library cannot be held responsible for the loss or damage of any of the displayed photos.
